Dear Dr. Glaziev,

RE: Project of the Century

I am an independent researcher, PhD (Candidate of Sciences), currently an Israeli pensioner, 78. I apply to you with a project vital for the destiny of civilization, for the destiny of Russia, in particular. Having read about your recent advice on economy to the President, I have decided to apply to you with the project, because you seem to be the right person to understand and start implementing it and because your ideology seems to be progressive and close to the true scientific one.

The project is based on my independent research in exact sciences and humanities, that I started 45 years ago in Russia and, since July 1992, have proceeded with abroad, achieving the following results:

- (1) reformed modern theoretical physics;
- (2) discovered the true philosophy of science: the true systems theory;
- (3) created a methodology for reforming modern science in general;
- (4) created the frameworks of the true sciences of politics and economics, the sciences nonexistent or underdeveloped before, with new fundamental results.

Those achievements, when recognized, would signify actually a turning point in the history of science and civilization. However, because of the present crisis of modern science and its institutions, the above achievements have not been recognized officially yet. Moreover, there is some kind of conspiracy against me aimed at isolating me from the scientific community. Nevertheless, I have managed to publish some of my works in hard copies and online.

In the course of the above research, it has become clear that the present monstrous crisis of modern science and its institutions has been underlying the present general ideological crisis of civilization, now at its crucial stage. **Therefore, for civilization to survive, it is necessary to start reforming modern science.** I have started such a reform, launched a dedicated website, but now I need an international support. So the aim of my project is to get support for and proceed with that mission. As you will see, the implementation of the project would be especially important for Russia, especially in the current ideological turmoil.

So I propose you to start advocating the establishing of THE REFORM SCIENCE CENTER (RSC), possibly in Switzerland, aimed at reforming modern science, philosophy and religion. The main tasks of the RSC would be as follows:

- (1) attracting highly professional researchers and philosophers worldwide to start reforming science in their field of interest, creating first frameworks of the new sciences and then developing them into textbooks and online courses for universities; my enclosed works being used for guidance and as examples;
- (2) attracting philosophers of religion to start creating the science of religion suitable for universities;
- (3) holding an online ARCHIVE to keep research works and a BULLETIN for the state of research;
- (4) raising a fund to run the Center, attract scientists, stimulate their work and reward their success.

If invited, I could run the Center and prepare younger researchers to substitute me when necessary. Otherwise somebody else could do that using my instructions and consulting me if necessary. It would be possible to start the project simply with editing, developing, publishing and teaching my enclosed

works. In time the Center may grow into a large institution worth getting support from UNESCO and perhaps joining it.

In this connection would you please discuss this project within the academy and possibly take over this mission thoroughly from me, because, in my current conditions in Israel, it would be impossible to start implementing the project. Please see more information enclosed. I am looking forward to your opinion.
