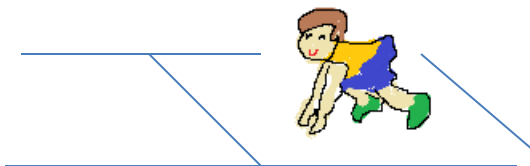

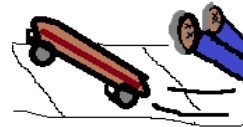


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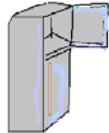

## Irregular Past Tense Verbs

This set contains 10 pages of cards for a total of 30 two sided cards; 3 ¼ inches by 2 ¾ inches when folded. These cards are set up so that the cards can be cut horizontally and remain joined in the middle. The right side card can be folded under the left side card making the back side and answer side of the card. You may want to glue them together to make a sturdier card. The QR codes provide the answer if you like to use a QR code reader. The reader I used is available at <http://www.qrstuff.com/>. There are a variety of apps that will work on mobile devices. If you have a UV pen you can write the answers in the blue boxes. The answer will be invisible until students light it up. Both of these methods will make it into a self checking activity.

I made these cards for students working on irregular past tense verbs to elicit the verbs within a natural sentence context. My commercial cards have pictures that don't reflect the past event and also print the word below. These cards are meant to solve those two problems by having the printed answer word hidden and providing a picture that reflects the past tense. I wanted an activity the students could use after they have memorize verbs according to the usual prompts of what happened today and then yesterday.

The cards may also be used for interpreting and answering questions that use the words before, after, during and while. They can be used for making predictions when given a context.
