Dear Ms. Mogherini,

RE: ideology for EU strategy and security

I am an independent researcher, PhD, an Israeli citizen, 79. During my half-life-long independent research in exact sciences and humanities, I have developed a scientific view of politics and think obliged to propose you a kind of cooperation concerning your mission, seeking at the same time your assistance in my project vital for civilization. The essence of my proposal is as follows.

My view of the present situation. Civilization has been experiencing a general ideological crisis now threatening the very existence of humankind; the root of that crisis is the crises of modern science, philosophy and religion; thus, to overcome the general crisis, it is necessary to start reforming these three spheres. Even the beginning of that process would be beneficial for civilization, because people would see the light ahead and start working towards it, helping to settle various conflicts, the currently intractable Israeli-Palestinian conflicts, in particular.

Providentially, I have started the above reform and developed the proper methodology for it. In total, I achieved the following results: (1) the discovery of the true systems theory; (2) the reform of modern theoretical physics; (3) the creation of the frameworks of the true sciences of politics and economics, the sciences nonexistent or underdeveloped before and socially most important. If recognized, the above achievements would amount to a turning point in the history of science and civilization.

The European and American establishment, however, have been stubbornly refusing to recognize those achievements and support my mission. The situation has been much aggravated by the activity of Russian agents conspiring against me everywhere and isolating me from the scientific community. No wonder I have seven times tried to get asylum in Europe and Canada, but failed.

The main culprit, however, is UNESCO, the BRAIN OF CIVILIZATION, responsible for the state of modern science, education and culture, that is for the world ideology; at present UNESCO seems to be thoroughly paralyzed being unable to work on the crisis. All that suggests that, for civilization to survive, it is necessary, first of all, to reorganize UNESCO and commit it to the reform of modern science, philosophy and religion as ITS MAIN MISSION. To support that change, it would be necessary also to start restructuring major world universities, in Europe at least.

In this connection, as the first step in implementing the above project, would you please take measures to organize a new department in UNESCO under my direction for two years, at least, devoted to the above reform. If necessary, you might preliminarily organize discussions of my works in physics, politics and theory of science in European universities. Please see the relevant papers enclosed.
