I apply to you seeking your assistance in realization of my project vital for the destiny of civilization, for the destiny of Russia, in particular. I am an independent researcher, PhD (Candidate of Sciences), currently an Israeli pensioner, 79.

The project is based on my independent research in exact sciences and humanities, that I started 45 years ago in Russia and, since July 1992, have proceeded with abroad, achieving the following:

(1) the reform of modern theoretical physics;

- (2) the discovery of the true philosophy of science: the true systems theory;
- (3) the creation of the methodology for reforming modern science in general;
- (4) the creation of the frameworks of the true sciences of politics and economics,

the sciences nonexistent or underdeveloped before and socially most important.

Those achievements, when recognized, would signify actually a turning point in the history of science and civilization; however, so far they have not been recognized officially.

In the course of the above research, it has become clear that the present monstrous crisis of modern science and its institutions, along with the crisis of modern philosophy and religion, has been underlying the present general ideological crisis, now at its crucial stage threatening the very existence of humankind. Therefore, for civilization to survive, it is necessary to start reforming modern science, philosophy and religion. I have started such a reform, launched a dedicated website to attract researchers and saw thousands of online visitors, yet silent. So now I would like to set up a small full-fledged NGO, possibly in Switzerland, to guide and coordinate the reform worldwide officially; to that end, I would certainly need a strong international support.

In this connection couldn't you please provide me with the RAS official review of my enclosed works in physics (astrophysics), philosophy of science, politics and economics.
