

# Pediatric Advanced Life

## Support (PALS)

**Course Description:** This classroom, video-based, Instructor-led course uses a series of simulated pediatric emergencies to reinforce the important concepts of a systematic approach to pediatric assessment, basic life support, PALS treatment algorithms, effective resuscitation and team dynamics. The goal of the PALS Course is to improve the quality of care provided to seriously ill or injured children, resulting in improved outcomes.

**Course Objectives:**

- Recognize and treat the infant or child at risk for cardiopulmonary arrest.
- Discuss the strategies for preventing cardiopulmonary arrest in infants and children.
- Demonstrate the assess-categorize-decide-act systematic approach to assessment and management of a seriously ill infant or child
- Demonstrate the cognitive and psychomotor skills necessary for resuscitating and stabilizing the infant or child using effective resuscitation team dynamics
