

THOMAS PARKER, her First Husband who died at Lancaster the 7th day of April 1768 aged 41 Years ALSO JOHN their Son who died the 10th Day of June 1768 aged 11 Months. This stone caused to be laid by their much Regreted (<i>sic</i>) Daughter FANNEY PARKER. Near this Stone lieth THOMAS COLLBANK her Second Husband who died the 22nd Day of January 1807 aged 72 Years. ALSO THOMAS their Son aged 5 Years. JOSEPH LAMBERT of ALLITHWAITE, died 9th May 1823 aged 70 Years.
