

1. **Introductory RBdigital and BenchPrep Positioning** – Show Gateway Dashboard and Learn More Page
 - a. BenchPrep for Libraries provides the best and most adaptive learning to prepare a patron for entrance exams for adult job vocations, advanced placement high school exams, major educational courses – and GED. Over 60 courses are available – and a user may enroll in all them without limit.
 - b. All BenchPrep for Libraries courses are available anytime through an active internet browser session on computers and mobile devices.
2. **RBdigital Gateway Dashboard** – Show Log In links
 - a. BenchPrep for Libraries is managed through the RBdigital Gateway with the convenience of a Single-Sign-On account. With a RBdigital Gateway account (i.e. Zinio or IndieFlix) your patrons simply log in –and a BenchPrep account is created for them.
3. **BenchPrep.com Library Instance Home Screen** – Show Menu of Courses and Descriptions
 - a. Users preview and enroll in courses – with most developed by global leaders in high school and adult course developers such as McGraw Hill and SourceBooks.
 - b. BenchPrep courses are organized to appeal to the variety of learning styles – Enroll in AP Chemistry AB or Firefighter's Exam.
4. **BenchPrep Course Dashboard** – Show User dashboard for enrolled course –
 - a. All courses are consistently developed for easy navigation and quick learning from one course to another.
 - b. BenchPrep course dashboard and screens are oriented to provide a consistent personal or social learning – however the user best learns.
5. **BenchPrep Icons and Links** – Show the learning center icons on left side of screens
 - a. Icons and Links help the user organize and provide a process for learning. Games, forums, tutors, discussion groups enhance the course work by putting study review in ways that reinforce learning style.
 - b. Study as privately or as socially as a user wants through profile settings.
 - c. Library users are defaulted as private users – but social settings are updated in Account Settings (show profile link in upper right of dashboard and study screens.)
6. **BenchPrep Course Content** is organized in and accessed through hyperlinked syllabus outlines. (Show Study Material link and practice center and test links.)
 - a. All courses begin with an overview of what is included and how to strategize learning preparation – and what to expect on test day.
 - b. Outlines may be followed in sequence or the user can jump ahead or around to whatever study segment they may find most useful during their study session(s).
 - c. In each study segment the user rates their confidence (Low, Medium, High) as well as ample space to put in notes or bookmarks for quick return and reference.
 - i. Show a few study segments and rate them
 - ii. Create a bookmark
 - iii. Create a new note
7. **BenchPrep Adaptive Learning** – tracks confidence ratings, notes and bookmarks organize review and further study need.

- a. Users may consolidate all their 'Low' ratings for example as a way to prioritize more study time in those sections – while building confidence with their 'High' ratings.
- 8. **BenchPrep Practice Review and Sample Tests** - helps users build confidence as test day approaches (show link at lower left of the dashboard and study pages).
- 9. **Study Help** (show Forums, Tutor, Discussion Groups, Social-User tracking)
 - a. Within each course the user may optionally get help from others taking the same course – or relate with a tutor via email for customized training.
 - b. Follow other users taking a course to see what they are studying (user names showed on the right side of the study screens – and only revealed if that user has social settings activated.)
- 10. **RE-POSITION** (go back to Home Icon – Dashboard)
 - a. As you shown in this short overview, BenchPrep provides a breadth and depth study to help the user strategize and develop the content knowledge to succeed in their test and entrance exam.
 - b. A user who studies BenchPrep courses has distinct advantages over those who passively study review books or don't study at all – based on the interactive nature, social setting options, adaptive study through the outline process followed in order – or user selected segments.
 - c. Most courses offered through schools or community or commercially services are often not available locally, are affordable, or start/end on a specific schedule or time of the course.
 - d. BenchPrep provides the courses anytime – inside the library or on the go – whenever the user needs to study.

KEY BENCHPREP FOR LIBRARIES FAQ:

- 1. The library instance is available through internet browser sessions – desktop and mobile devices.
- 2. The BenchPrep.com mobile app – is ONLY available to commercial paying consumers
- 3. The courses do not time out – or expire.
- 4. There is no limit to the number of courses a user may enroll in.
- 5. GED currently is being redesigned nationwide – only a MATH review course is available in BenchPrep.
- 6. BenchPrep.com commercial site has additional courses available for commercial paying consumers.
- 7. Users with a commercial paying account AND a LIBRARY instance account activated through RBdigital Gateway will not merge.
