1. Chairman Wyssling opened the Meeting at 5:30 P.M.

City Clerk Karen Gullan administered the oath to Planning Commission members LeRoy Johnson and Robert Burchell.

2. Recording of the Roll.

3. Election of Officers

7. Project Updates

Assessor/Building Inspector Dennis Hewitt updated the Planning Commission regarding Ottawa Forest Products, Super 1, and El Dorado.

NEW BUSINESS

8. Discuss and consider request from Angelo Luppino to purchase City owned property located on S. Davis Road.

Angelo Luppino addressed the Planning Commission regarding his request to purchase of a City of Ironwood's 60-acre parcel for \$10,000.00.

Mr. Luppino stated he has blacktopped his driveway. He noted the City and others use this access to the stockpiles located on his property. Mr. Luppino also mentioned he has purchased some of the materials from the City in the past for a fee. He felt the property was low land and there really was no value.

Planning Commissioner Johnson handed out a map of the property noting there were 19 airshafts on this property.

The Planning Commission after a brief discussion stated their job is only to recommend to the City Commission placing this on the surplus property list. Further discussion of this matter took place.

Motion was made by Bergman, seconded by Burchell and carried to place the 60-acre parcel on the next agenda to discuss and consider recommending the parcel to be placed on the surplus property list.

Dennis Hewitt, City Assessor/Building Inspector stated permitted uses for outdoor signs was now listed under conditional uses in the new ordinance.

He further stated the fee for a conditional use permit was \$500.

The Planning Commission felt in their opinion the non-premise business sign would need to go through the Conditional Use Permit process. Further discussion took place.
