# THE PROGRAM OF THE NEW MARXIST PARTY OF GERMANY Project

Now that the growing confrontation between the West and the East, in Ukraine and Syria in particular, threatens with a new world war, it is urgently necessary for every Marxist party to analyze the whole situation and propose the program of actions to settle the present geopolitical crisis. In this connection, given the present repressive regime in Russia, the party New Marxists of Russia proposes the following program of actions for a hypothetical New Marxist Party of Germany.

### 1. The geopolitical crisis

The present geopolitical crisis is caused by the present general *ideological* crisis of civilization. This general crisis cannot be resolved by technological means and military efforts: it can only be resolved by ideological means, by reforming the ideology of modern society. To that end, it would be necessary to reform modern science, philosophy and religion – the spheres of intellectual activity responsible for the ideology of society. We have started such a reform, achieved significant results in exact sciences and humanities and developed a general methodology for the reform [1]. However, the conservative circles of establishment have refused to support the reform considering it a threat to their current privileges. So no wonder that, without the general ideological reform, the development of the ideological crisis has resulted in the spread of terrorist activity and the present geopolitical crisis now threatening the very existence of humankind.

Fortunately, the beginning of the above reform has made it possible to work out the frameworks of the true sciences in politics and economics [1] and, therefore, a new version of Marxism – Marxism-21 [2]. That political theory has enabled us to propose this program of actions to the leftist parties of Europe, of Germany in particular, where the atmosphere of liberty, on the one hand, and the Marxist tradition, on the other hand, make ideological and political progress possible.

# 2. Transition to socialism in Germany

The current political and ideological situation in Germany may be depicted, in short, as follows:

- (1) the capitalist economy in Germany has achieved its thorough development and therefore is ready to transform to a higher, socialist, stage;
- (2) the political system in Germany has achieved its thorough development, is experiencing a crisis and is ready to transform to self-governance;
- (3) the European society in general, in Germany in particular, is especially anxious about the present geopolitical crisis and, psychologically, is ready to socialist transformation.

In this connection, taking into account that the new political theory confirms the necessity of eventual transition to socialism, the New Marxist Party of Germany starts doing the following:

- (1) starts an aggressive propaganda of the new political theory and the new version of Marxism in Germany and, possibly, in Eastern Europe including Ukraine and Russia;
- (2) undertakes efforts to include the new political and economic theories in the programs of schools and universities;
- (3) undertakes efforts to create a public sector of economy competing with the existing private one;
- (4) undertakes efforts to replace the current political system by self-governance on the regional and federal levels, as substantiated and described in our two articles [3], [4].

The above measures should result in transforming the German society into the socialist one.

# 3. Promoting socialism in Eastern Europe including Ukraine

After success in Germany, the same package of measures should be applied in Eastern Europe, from Finland to Greece, from the Czech Republic to Ukraine. As a result the countries of the Eastern Europe, enlightened by the true political theory, would start replacing their current capitalistic and nationalistic ideologies by the socialist one, thus settling all major political and nationalistic conflicts.

# 4. Promoting socialism in Russia, Caucasus and Middle Asia

After success in Eastern Europe, the same package of measures should be applied in Russia, Caucasus and Middle Asia. As a result those countries, enlightened by the true political theory, would also start replacing their current capitalistic and nationalistic ideologies by the socialist one, thus settling all major political and nationalistic conflicts.

# 5. Importance of religion

Religion is the only ideology destined and able to unite the whole civilization into one living organism. Without such a unity, it would be impossible to achieve social harmony and peace. So, in contrast to the orthodox Marxism, its modern version includes religion as one of its fundamental constituents. However, at present the world religion is severed into various religious systems often conflicting with each other. Therefore, for a smooth transition to socialism, it would be necessary to start, as early as possible, reforming modern religion into *the science of religion* suitable for universities and, with some reduction, for schools. Such a reform would be especially important for East European, Middle East and Asian countries. For such a reform to succeed, we recommend to use the methodology stated in our work [1].

#### Conclusion

The realization of the above program seems to be the only way to reverse the current growth of the West-East confrontation, to stop religious terrorism, to settle local conflicts, to choose the right environmental policy, to start nuclear disarmament and ensure a secure development of civilization. The implementation of this program would be beneficial for the whole world, in all spheres of life.
