RE: appeal for support

I am an independent researcher, PhD, an Israeli citizen, currently a pensioner, 80. During my independent research in exact sciences and humanities, that I started 45 years ago in Russia and since 1992 have proceeded with in Israel, Europe and Canada, I achieved the following:

- (1) reformed modern theoretical physics;
- (2) discovered the true philosophy of science: the true systems theory;
- (3) created a methodology for reforming modern science in general;
- (4) created the frameworks of the true sciences of politics and economics, the sciences nonexistent or underdeveloped before and socially most important.

The recognition of the above achievements would signify actually a turning point in the history of science and civilization. However, because of the present crisis of modern science and its institutions, those achievements have not been recognized officially yet. Moreover, there seems to be some kind of conspiracy against me initiated perhaps by Russian agents and aimed at isolating me from the scientific community. Nevertheless, I have managed to publish some of my works in hard copies and online.

In the course of the above research, it has become clear that the present monstrous crisis of modern science and its institutions, along with the crisis of modern philosophy and religion, has been underlying the present general ideological crisis, now at its crucial stage threatening the very existence of humankind. Therefore, for civilization to survive, it is necessary to start reforming modern science, philosophy and religion. I have started such a reform, launched a dedicated website, but such a historic mission cannot hinge long on the enthusiasm of a pensioner - it needs a wide international support.

At present I have been seeking an opportunity to establish an NGO, possibly in Switzerland, titled perhaps THE WORLD REFORM CENTER (WRC), aimed at reforming modern science, philosophy and religion. The main tasks of the WRC would be as follows:

- (1) attracting highly professional researchers and philosophers worldwide to start reforming science in their field of interest, creating first frameworks of the new sciences and then developing them into textbooks and online courses for universities; my enclosed works being used for guidance and as examples; at present I expect great results in reforming biology and microbiology, in particular;
- (2) attracting philosophers of religion to create the science of religion suitable for universities;
- (3) holding an online ARCHIVE to keep research works and a BULLETIN for the state of research;
- (4) raising a fund to run the Center, attract scientists, stimulate their work and reward their success; I expect enthusiastic donations from organizations and private persons.

I think the Rosa Luxemburg Foundation in Israel might support this my mission with great benefits for the Israeli and European science, research, education and society. I would like to run the Center, for two years at least, and prepare younger researchers to substitute me when necessary. Then the Foundation could take over the mission and run it using my instructions and consulting me if necessary. It would be possible to start the project simply with editing, developing, publishing and teaching my enclosed works. In time the Center may grow into a large institution worth getting support from UNESCO.

In this connection would you please consider the possibility of sponsoring my WRC project for two years at least. Please find enclosed my works, my CV and other relevant papers.
