

Community Support Worker

Seeking caring person to provide Community Living Support to a 20-year-old man with schizoaffective disorder, living in Ann Arbor. The Community Support Worker will be responsible for ensuring his wellbeing and promoting his development and independence according to his Individualized Plan.

Job responsibilities include coaching and support with daily living activities, including meal planning, shopping, preparing food, doing dishes, cleaning, managing money, exercising, participating in educational and recreational activities, and providing transportation and support to access services as needed to meet his goals and progress towards independence.

Ideal candidate is responsible, self-motivated, organized, positive, easy-going, and flexible. Must have a valid drivers license, reliable transportation, and a good driving record. Must be willing to learn about the disorder, communication methods, and the specific needs of the individual. Some experience is preferred, but training will be provided. Must be available to work weekdays.
