Dear Mr. Levrat,

RE: proposal of cooperation of historic importance

I apply to you with a proposal of cooperation which would provide the party with the true ideology, greatly enhance its popularity and could increase its fund. I propose the party to support my project aimed at reforming modern science and religion and provide me with the necessary living and working conditions for that mission - for two years, at least. The realization of the project is of vital importance for the destiny of Europe and civilization as a whole. The background of the project is as follows.

I am an independent researcher, PhD, an Israeli citizen, currently a pensioner, 80. The project is based on my decades-long independent research in exact sciences and humanities that, due to its radically new method, enabled me to achieve results of fundamental importance and work out a methodology for reforming modern science in general.

The main idea of my project is as follows. Civilization has been experiencing a general ideological crisis now threatening the very existence of humankind. Underlying that crisis is the crisis of modern science, philosophy and religion – the three spheres of human intellectual activity responsible for the ideology of modern society. Thus, to resolve the above general crisis, it is necessary to reform the above three spheres. I have started such a reform, launched a dedicated website and achieved significant results, but such a historic mission cannot hinge long on the enthusiasm of a pensioner - it needs a wide international support.

At present I have been seeking an opportunity to establish an NGO, possibly in Switzerland, titled perhaps THE WORLD REFORM CENTER (WRC), committed to the above mission. The main tasks of the WRC would be as follows:

- (1) attracting highly professional researchers and philosophers worldwide to start reforming science in their field of interest, creating first frameworks of the new sciences and then developing them into textbooks and online courses for universities; my enclosed works being used for guidance;
- (2) attracting philosophers of religion to create the science of religion suitable for universities;
- (3) raising a fund to run the Center, attract scientists, stimulate their work and reward their success.

I expect enthusiastic donations from organizations and private persons, the donations to be shared with the party.

I would like to run the project for two years at least and prepare young researchers to substitute me when necessary. Meanwhile I would try to get command of the basic German, participate in the activity of the party and possibly read lectures on the new physics, the science of politics and the philosophy of science.

In this connection would you please consider the possibility to provide me with the conditions necessary to establish and run the above Center (in the beginning a small office for 7-10 persons) for two years at least. Please see additional information enclosed.
