Dear Prof. Günther,

RE: proposal of cooperation

I am an independent researcher, PhD, an Israeli citizen, currently a pensioner, 80. During my independent research in systems theory, exact sciences and humanities, that I started 45 years ago in Russia and since 1992 have proceeded with in Israel, Europe and Canada, I achieved the following:

- (1) reformed modern theoretical physics;
- (2) discovered the true philosophy of science: the true systems theory;
- (3) created the frameworks of the true sciences of politics and economics;
- (4) created a methodology for reforming modern science in general.

The recognition of the above achievements would signify actually a turning point in the history of science and civilization. However, because mainly of my status of independent researcher, they have not been recognized officially yet. Nevertheless, I have published privately my research on paper and online and have been trying now to proceed with a new mission, as explained below.

As events suggest, civilization has been experiencing a general ideological crisis now threatening its very existence. Underlying that crisis, as my analysis shows, is the crises of modern science, philosophy and religion. Thus, to resolve this general crisis, it is necessary to reform the above three spheres. I have started such a reform, launched a dedicated website and achieved significant results, but such a historic mission cannot hinge long on the enthusiasm of a pensioner - it needs a broad international support. To organize and coordinate such a reform on a global scale is the aim of my new mission.

At present I have been seeking an opportunity to establish a coordinating center committed to the above reforming activity and run it for two years, at least; its main tasks being as follows:

- (1) attracting highly professional researchers and philosophers worldwide to start reforming science in their fields of interest using my methodology;
- (2) attracting philosophers of religion to create the science of religion suitable for universities;
- (3) (optional) raising a fund to run the center and stimulate the researchers.

It would perhaps expedient for the ETH Zürich to include my mission into its current list of programs, create a new ETH-department dedicated to that mission and invite me to run it for two years, at least. However, for ETH Zürich to be sure that my above achievements are not scientific fiction, but the only true line of fundamental research in the respective fields, on the one hand, and for me to be sure that my above achievements are properly recognized, on the other hand, it would be necessary, as a first thing, to organize the following:

- (1) my defence of my original research in physics [1] enclosed as a doctorate in physics, and
- (2) my defence of my work [2] enclosed as a doctorate in philosophy (theory of science).

In this connection would you please consider the possibility of organizing the above two defences of my respective works and then, in case of success, joining my mission to the current list of ETH-programs - with great benefits for the ETH Zürich, civilization and this country, in particular. Please find additional information on the issue in the papers enclosed. I would appreciate your confirmation of this email, your early opinion of it and the decision on it possibly by 12.11.15.
