Dear Ms. Director-General of UNESCO,

RE: individual partnership becoming institute

I am an independent researcher, Candidate of Science in Technology (approximately PhD), an Israeli citizen, currently a pensioner, 80. I appeal to you for a UNESCO partnership for my mission vital, in my opinion, for the destiny of civilization, as follows.

In the course of my decades-long independent research in exact sciences and humanities, that I started 45 years ago in Russia and since 1992 have proceeded with in Israel, Europe and Canada, I have achieved the following:

- (1) reformed modern theoretical physics;
- (2) discovered the true philosophy of science: the true systems theory;
- (3) created the frameworks of the true sciences of politics and economics;
- (4) worked out a methodology for reforming modern science in general.

Recognition of the above achievements would signify actually a turning point in the history of science and civilization. However, because mainly of my status of independent researcher, those achievements have not been recognized officially yet. Nevertheless, I have managed to publish some of my works on paper and online.

In the course of the above research, it has become clear that the present monstrous crisis of modern science and its institutions, along with the crisis of philosophy and religion, has been underlying the present general ideological crisis of civilization, the crisis now threatening the very existence of humankind. Therefore, for civilization to survive, it is necessary to reform modern science, philosophy and religion. I have started such a reform, achieved significant results, launched a dedicated website already visited by thousands, but such a historic mission cannot hinge long on the enthusiasm of a pensioner - it needs a wide international support. The more so that it is thoroughly consistent with the UNESCO mandate; so the best solution would be to commit UNESCO to that reformatory mission. Otherwise it would be necessary to set up a new scientific institution, certainly under the auspices of UNESCO, to proceed with that mission on a large scale.

Accordingly, at present I have been seeking an opportunity to establish an NGO, possibly in Switzerland, titled perhaps THE WORLD REFORM CENTER (WRC), aimed at reforming modern science, philosophy and religion. The main tasks of the WRC would be as follows:

- (1) attracting professional researchers and philosophers to reform science in their field of interest;
- (2) attracting philosophers of religion to create the science of religion suitable for universities;
- (3) raising a fund to run the Center, stimulate the work of researchers and reward their success.

I would like to run the Center, for two years at least, and prepare younger researchers to substitute me when necessary.

In this connection, taking into account that the decision on this issue may prove vital for the destiny of civilization. would you please:

- (1) organize an independent scientific expertize of my enclosed works; and, in case of its success,
- (2) consider the possibility of organizing a new UNESCO department dedicated to the above reformatory mission - under my direction for two years, at least; or otherwise
- (3) consider the possibility of establishing a new UNESCO institute dedicated to the above mission - under my direction for two years, at least.

Please find enclosed my above research works, my CV and other relevant papers.
