Traceworks is a new, contemporary dance company. All members of the company are professionally trained and actively working in the dance industry. We are looking for a museum/gallery interested in commissioning the company to create/perform an entirely new dance work and create the work in residence at the venue. We are available the week beginning **9 May** (with Museums at Night 2016 being the **11-14 May**) and imagine using the museum as a creative hub where we find the stimulus for our work, create and rehearse during the day(s) and then perform at the end of the residency. With the company in residence, the project will be a truly authentic collaboration with the museum as well as bring greater interest and wider audience engagement. As well as live rehearsals and performances, we can offer Q&A sessions and workshops.

In 2011, co-director of Traceworks, Julian David Lewis directed a similar collaboration at the Museum of Bath at Work for Museums at Night whereby the dancers performed a new work inspired by the machinery and working history exhibited in the museum. This went on to encourage other dance groups to use the space creatively including Earthfall Dance and Bath Spa University.
