YCC 256 & 367 Pool Rules

- 1. The Lifeguard is in charge and must be obeyed at all times. Failure to do so will result in eviction from the pool area.
- 2. The pool may be used **ONLY** when the lifeguard is on duty.
- 3. All swimmers must take a cleansing shower or bath before entering the pool.
- 4. All weak and non-swimmers are restricted to the shallow end of the pool.
- 5. Persons with communicable diseases or open sores will **NOT** be allowed in the pool.
- 6. All swimmers and guests must sign in using the log book when entering the pool area.
- All children under the age of twelve (12) must be accompanied by an adult (over 18 years of age). Please note this person **MUST** remain with the child in the pool area. Children left unattended will be asked to leave the pool area for their safety.
- 8. Safety equipment should **NOT** be used as toys. **DO NOT** sit or hang on the pool dividing rope.
- 9. Diving, running, pushing, excessive splashing/horseplay and water guns are prohibited.
- 10. Hair that is shoulder length or longer must be tied back.
- 11. No person shall pollute the water by urinating, spitting, blowing their nose or spouting water.
- 12. Abusive language will not be tolerated and will result in eviction from the pool area.
- 13. A maximum of **30** people are allowed in the pool and on the pool deck at one given time.
- 14. Please limit your guests to 2 so that a maximum number of people can enjoy the pool, and remain with them at all times.
- 15. The pool phone and bathroom are **ONLY** to be used by the lifeguard.
- 16. Anyone caught entering the pool after hours will be subject to a season ban.
