

Proceedings of the Ironwood City Commission Work Session

A Work Session with the Ironwood City Commission took place to discuss the Rural Development Funding application for Phase III Water & Sewer and the 2012-2013 Fiscal Year Budget will be held on Thursday, May 17, 2012 starting at 3:00 P.M. in the Women's Club Room, Memorial Building, 2nd Floor Memorial Building, 213 S. Marquette Street, Ironwood, MI 49938.

Also present: City Manager Erickson, City Clerk Gullan, Assessor/Building Inspector Hewitt, Public Safety Director DiGiorgio, DPW Superintendant Richards, Utilities Manager Tervonen, Finance Director Linn, and Jeff Sjoquist from Coleman Engineering.

Jeff Sjoquist from Coleman Engineering addressed the City Commission regarding the U.S. Rural Development Funding Application for Phase III Water & Sewer Project. Mr. Sjoquist explained to the City Commission the City of Ironwood's sewer and water rates and different funding scenarios for the future water and sewer work along Highway US 2 and the neighborhoods north of the Kmart Plaza. Mr. Sjoquist noted Rural Development has informed the City of Ironwood it would be 100% loan and grant funding is not on the table. Further discussion of this matter took place.

Finance Director Paul Linn discussed with the City Commission the draft of the proposed 2012-2013 Fiscal Year Budget. Finance Director Linn noted most expenditure accounts were put back to last year figures. Further discussion of this matter took place.
