

School Admissions

Any student seeking entrance into the South Shore School District must reside within the established boundaries of the district, except as otherwise provided. The building principal shall verify the age and residence of children enrolled in the district schools.

Building principals shall have authority to determine the grade level at which a student shall be placed. Students transferring into the district shall provide academic transcripts from their previous school, or the address from which this data may be secured. If adequate academic transcript information is not available, the principal may require the student to take appropriate academic tests to assist in making the placement.

Students transferring into the district from a home-schooling program will provide the school with a written description of the home school curriculum used and a calendar noting the time dedicated to instruction. The school will use the above to determine placement. The school reserves the right to test the students' academic development to determine the appropriate level of placement.

Parents or guardians of students admitted to the districts elementary and secondary schools shall present immunization records as required by law.

The South Shore School District shall not discriminate in admissions to any school, class, program or activity on the basis of sex, race, color, religion, national origin, ancestry, creed, age, pregnancy, marital status or parental status, sexual orientation, gender identity, physical, mental, emotional, or learning disability, or other basis prohibited under state or federal law. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
