Dear Mrs. Prime Minister,

RE: a mission vital for civilization

I am an independent researcher, PhD, an Israeli citizen, 80. I appeal to you for assistance in my scientific mission aimed at resolving the present general ideological crisis of civilization now threatening the very existence of humankind. To resolve the crisis, it would be necessary to reform modern science, philosophy and religion. I have started such a reform, achieved significant results and developed a general methodology of the reform. Now to proceed with that mission I need a strong international support.

My achievements, if acknowledged officially, would amount perhaps to a turning point in the history of science and civilization. Regrettably their acknowledgment has been obstructed by the following factors:

- (1) the omnipresent secret war against me being waged by Russian agents and aimed at isolating me from the scientific community, first of all in Europe and Israel;
- (2) the super-conservative attitude of modern scientific establishment scared by the prospect of the reform of modern science;
- (3) corruption and a biased attitude of scientific institutions, scientific funds and immigration authorities in Europe.

However as the monstrous crises of modern science and religion are the main sources of the above ideological crisis, the delay of their reform presents a growing threat to the destiny of civilization, for example, by the growing threat of nuclear war and terrorist activity, to say the least. Therefore, giving priority to the destiny of civilization against the privileges of modern scientific establishment, we should find, whatever the cost, the way to start reforming modern science, philosophy and religion on a broad scale. More on the matter is stated in the online documents enclosed.

In this connection, following the traditional British way of liberty and progress, would you please consider an opportunity to provide me with all the necessary conditions to proceed with the above mission in Britain, organizing, to begin with, my report on the mission.
