Dear Dr. Bokova,

RE: appeal for support of the world mission (new email)

I appeal to you on matters VITAL FOR THE DESTINY OF CIVILIZATION. I am an independent researcher, PhD, an Israeli citizen, 81.

### **My research**

During my almost 40-year-long independent research, that I started in Russia late in the 60s and since 1992 have proceeded with in Israel, Europe and Canada, I achieved the following:

- (1) reformed modern theoretical physics;
- (2) created the frameworks of the true sciences of politics and economics, the sciences nonexistent or underdeveloped before and socially most important;
- (3) discovered the true interpretation of the General System Theory - the philosophy of science.

Those results, if recognized officially, would amount to a turning point in the history of science and civilization. Seeking recognition of my research, I have repeatedly applied to conferences, universities and foundations, as well as to UNESCO, but in vain. The main reasons for the above failure seem to be (1) my status of independent researcher, (2) corruption and obscurantism of European universities and (3) a sup-posed conspiracy against me initiated by Russian agents and involving the Israeli and European establishment.

### **My current mission**

As an analysis shows, civilization has been experiencing A GENERAL IDEOLOGICAL CRISIS now threatening the very existence of humankind. Particular manifestations of the latter are the current war in Syria, the crisis in Ukraine, the Israeli-Palestinian conflict. To resolve that general crisis, it is necessary TO REFORM MODERN SCIENCE, PHILOSOPHY AND RELIGION – the three spheres of human intellectual activity responsible for the ideology of modern society. My research opens the way to such a reform; moreover I have already started it. To proceed with that mission, however, I need an international support to set up a COORDINATING CENTER necessary to attract researchers the world over, guide and stimulate their work, and train some of them to substitute me when necessary. The best solution would be to reorganize UNESCO and commit it to the above mission. Otherwise it would be necessary to set up a new institution, possibly in Europe, dedicated to the above mission. Conditions in Israel are absolutely incompatible with that mission, and there is no hope to change them; moreover, there is no reliable communication there.

### **My appeal to you**

In this connection would you please take urgent measures to provide me with conditions appropriate for my above mission, possibly in Europe. Please see my relevant works, documents, papers and letters enclosed.
