

## So where do we find children and young people? Lle gawn ni hyd i blant a phobl ifanc?

### Schools

- If your museum already works with a local school talk to the contact teacher
- A member of staff or volunteer probably has personal links with a local school through their children, grandchildren or being a governor for example
- To find your local schools see: [My Local School](#)

#### Primary schools (ages 4-11)

- Contact a class teacher who is familiar with your museum
- Send a letter or email to the Head
- Use the local authority bulletin or newsletter to invite schools
- The Children's Commissioner for Wales runs a Super Ambassadors scheme for primary schools. Every local authority in Wales now has at least one ambassador school. For further information: visit [Children's Commissioner for Wales](#) and [Super Ambassadors](#)

#### Secondary Schools (ages 11-16/18) and FE Colleges (16+)

- Contact the Head of a specific subject department e.g. Engineering, Art, Business Studies, Leisure & Tourism. To find out which subjects a school or college offers take a look around their website for a prospectus, subject or staff list.
- Check the school's website and the local press to find out what your local school is interested in or planning and approach them about working together. Schools will be keen on opportunities linked to their current or future interests e.g. an important anniversary, a project to improve particular pupil skills.

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### Ysgolion

- Os yw eich amgueddfa'n gweithio gydag ysgolion lleol yn barod, siaradwch gyda'r athro cyswllt
- Mae'n debyg bod gan aelod o staff neu wirfoddolwr gysylltiadau personol gydag ysgol leol drwy eu plant, eu hwyron neu drwy fod yn lywodraethwr, er enghraifft

#### Ysgolion cynradd (4-11 oed)

- Cysylltwch ag athro dosbarth sy'n gyfarwydd â'ch amgueddfa
- Anfonwch lythyr neu e-bost at y Pennaeth
- Defnyddiwch daflen newyddion neu fwletin yr awdurdod lleol i wahodd ysgolion

#### Ysgolion Uwchradd (11-16/18 oed) a Cholegau AB (16+)

- Cysylltwch â Phennaeth adran pwnc penodol e.e. Peirianneg, Celf, Astudiaethau Busnes, Hamdden a Thwristiaeth. I ganfod pa bynciau mae ysgol neu goleg yn eu cynnig edrychwch o amgylch eu gwefan i weld prospectws, rhestr pynciau neu restr staff.
- Gwiriwch wefan yr ysgol a'r wasg leol i ganfod mewn pa bethau mae gan eich ysgol ddiddordeb neu beth yw eu cynlluniau a gofynnwch iddynt ynglŷn â chydweithio. Bydd ysgolion yn awyddus i gael cyfleoedd sy'n gysylltiedig â'u buddiannau presennol neu eu buddiannau yn y dyfodol e.e. pen-blwydd pwysig, prosiect i wella sgiliau disgybl penodol.

## What else should we consider?

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- Schools will need time to make arrangements so start conversations sooner rather than later
- Primary schools often find it easier to come out of school for the day than secondary schools, but staff will need to accompany the children so they might be more keen if you can accommodate a whole class
- Job titles, particularly in secondary schools, vary so look at their website or call the school or college reception to find out the best person to speak to
