


Tatted Star Motif



Materials:

- 1 tatting shuttle
- Ball of thread (any size)
- Small steel crochet hook (to help with joins)
- Needle to sew in ends
- Scissors
- Steam iron











Start: Wind the shuttle with about 2 yards of thread, and leave attached to the ball. R 7 - 2 - 2 - 7. RW. Ch 2 - 5 - 2. RW.

*R7-2-2-7. RW.

Ch 2 + 5 - 2 (to last picot of previous Ch). RW.

Repeat from * until there are a total of 4 rings and 4 chains from the start.



R ring

RW reverse work

- picot

+ join



5th ring and chain:

R7-2-2-7. RW.

Ch 2 + 5 + 2 (first join to last picot of previous Ch, 2nd join to first picot of first Ch).




and tie securely


Finishing: Cut threads, leaving tails long enough to sew in.

Tie a square knot at the base of the first ring, then sew ends under the caps of the stitches, tug to hide, and cut.

Block with steam.















Start: Wind the shuttle with about 3 yards of thread, and leave attached to the ball. R 4 - 3 - 1 - 1 - 1 - 3 - 4. RW. Ch 2 - 2 - 2 - 2. RW.

* R 4 - 3 - 1 - 1 - 1 - 1 - 3 - 4. RW.

Ch 2 + 2 - 2 - 2 (to last picot of previous Ch). RW. Repeat from * until there are a total of 5 rings and 5 chains from the start.



6th ring and chain:

R4-3-1-1-1-3-4. RW.

Ch 2 + 2 - 2 + 2 (first join to last picot of previous Ch, second join to first picot of first Ch).

Finishing:

Cut threads, leaving tails long enough to sew in.

Tie a square knot at the base of the first ring, then sew ends under the caps of the stitches, tug to hide, and cut.

Block with steam.
