

## ACB Meeting Notes 3/11/17

### House mom report

- Parking Lot Discussion
  - Fall parking is starting to get assigned
  - 20 spots will be designated for Delt Sigs, 15 designated for ADPi
    - 15 will be sold to DG
- We got the new refrigerator and ice cube dispenser in the Butler's Pantry
- House will close at 12 on Saturday the 25<sup>th</sup> for spring break
- Mom's weekend is April 8-9<sup>th</sup>
  - Planning on a brunch Saturday morning with Chef John
- Letter from cleaning service, regarding undergrads helping to clean, and being very well mannered
  - They clean Mon, Tue, Thur, Fri 8:30 to 2:30
    - Changed to Mon, Wed, Fri from now on
  - At \$18 an hour
  - Discussion about changing Cleaning service companies to a cheaper alternative tabled until next meeting

### Treasurer's Report

- Trying to get our reserve account back to what we expect
  - Around \$100,000
- Mortgage is currently at \$1.65 Million
- Members who have not paid will be suspended from eating beginning Tuesday
- Karl is looking into automatically reporting unpaid dues after 30 days to credit agencies
- Lawsuit against Pearson has been settled
  - Signed a promissory note
- Sean Durant has been paid his past dues and the lawsuit has been settled
- In house prices are going to be rising to \$5,000 a semester from the previous \$4,750
  - Vote Passed
- We will be getting an average house bill from other fraternities to advertise our price
- Undergrad Executive Board will prepare a housing plan and present it at the next meeting
- Out-of-House contracts will be valid until the undergrad graduates from now on
  - As opposed to every semester like it has been
  - Out-of-House contract motion passes; Brian Motioned, Bryson Seconded
- House activity fee will no longer be a part of the house bill in the next semester

### House Report

- 19 remaining in house, 3 new members moving in, 12 possibly moving in
  - brings us to approx 37 in house
- Sigma Pi Party

- o Meeting with July Drury seemed to go well
- Discussion on the effects of pulling out of IFC
  - Was more about information on other Fraternities
- An ambulance was called to the house by a member on himself
  - o He was not in the house when he was consuming marijuana
- Greek week pairings
  - o We are paired with Kappa this semester
- Brian would like a report on rush for the next semester
  - o Rush Chair will be here

### New Member Report

- Undergrads now have a rush committee
  - o Creates rush chairs for Chicago, St. Louis, Kansas City that report to the Rush Chair
- We need to communicate with Brian about potential Rushes GPAs
- Average GPA for current new members is 3.03
- Initiation will be April 13<sup>th</sup>
- Undergrads are looking into mandating that pledges move in house
- SOP on new members
  - o Mandates pinning within the first week of the start of the semester
  - o Initiation must be 8 week after
  - o Both dates must be given ahead of time
  - o Changed pinning to 14 calendar days after the first day of school
- Motion to accept started by Bruce; Seconded by
  - o Passed

### 90<sup>th</sup> anniversary talk

- Ball room is booked for September 15<sup>th</sup> before the Purdue football game
- Will be a dinner/dance with both alumni and undergrads
- Will be formal with Suits/Tuxedos, with a dinner
- Will be a live band after the dinner is over
- Cost for dinner will be around \$40 a person
- Two possible financing options, one for people who do not want to pay the \$40 for the dinner who can stay up top in the ballroom for the speeches, and then join everyone on the main floor, and another for people who will pay for the dinner
- For undergrads it will be approx \$25 or under

### Old Business

- Deck Discussion
  - o Costs approx \$30, 000 for the deck as well as basketball court on the other side
  - o Undergraduate chapter will fundraise 1/3 of the cost and ACB will pledge the rest
  - o Final vote will occur during the April meeting

- Undergrads will propose funding ideas, as well as finalized plans

#### New Business

- Discussion on building two story parking garage
  - Have architectures do a concept drawing
  - Possible have alumni pledge money, and then be paid back money as it earns it
