

The community center was originally built as the Gnesen School and is located at 6356 Howard Gnesen Rd approximately 13 miles north of Duluth. The building has many great features including a gym (with curtained stage), cafeteria with full kitchen and several rooms for meetings. Outside is an outdoor tennis court and large playground. The parking lot is paved and has marked handicap parking close to the doors.

Fee schedule:

Classroom	Holds up to 35 people and is equipped with a kitchen, banquet-size tables & chairs. Suitable for showers, small parties, etc. (No alcohol is allowed)	\$35/4 hours
Gym	For one-time or on-going sporting activities such as basketball, volleyball, exercise groups, etc. (No alcohol is allowed)	\$20/month
Gym	For open & voluntarily supervised on-going community youth & parenting groups, pre-school playgroups, etc. (No alcohol is allowed)	No charge
Gym/Kitchen Town Hall	For smaller gatherings such as funeral luncheons, church plays, open houses, etc. (No alcohol is allowed)	\$50/resident \$100/non-resident
Gym/Kitchen Town Hall	For larger gatherings such as banquets, family reunions, private parties, etc. (Additional security fee when serving alcohol)*	\$175/resident \$450/non-resident
Entire Facility	For all day purposes, such as large wedding receptions. Rental includes the gym, kitchen, classroom & outdoor recreation area. (Additional security fee when serving alcohol)*	\$250/resident \$500/non-resident
The tennis court and backyard facility are available daily for community use on a first come first serve basis.		

***All events held at the Gnesen Community Center that serve liquor of any kind are required to pay an additional security fee for the security guard at \$58/hour.** (If alcoholic beverages are served, no fee shall be charged for such beverages.)

There is a \$250.00 deposit required for rentals with alcohol and \$100.00 deposit without alcohol.
