MAKING A BELT POUCH

Wet formed belt pouch for a Leatherman Wave with extras.



Leather



[2-2.5mm veg tan shoulder](#) or [economy veg tan 2.0-2.4mm](#)— these leathers can be stamped and embossed and wet moulded.

Alternatively use the [heavy weight stallion](#), or [waxy bullhide](#) (bullhide is mineral tanned and won't edge slick—use with Identity Store Leading Edge Foundation)

Tools:

[Awl](#), [Wood-slicker](#) or [Bone folder](#) for edges, creasing and wet forming, [Stitching Needles](#), [Line 20 press stud \(snap\) setter](#) and [mini dot anvil](#)

Materials:

[Waxed stitching thread](#) also available in black or natural

[Identity Store Water Based Leather Stain](#) available in several colours—try English Tan for a similar colour to the image.

[Line 20 press studs \(snaps\)](#) also available in brass or black plate finishes

[Neatsfoot oil](#) or [Veg Protec](#) for waterproofing

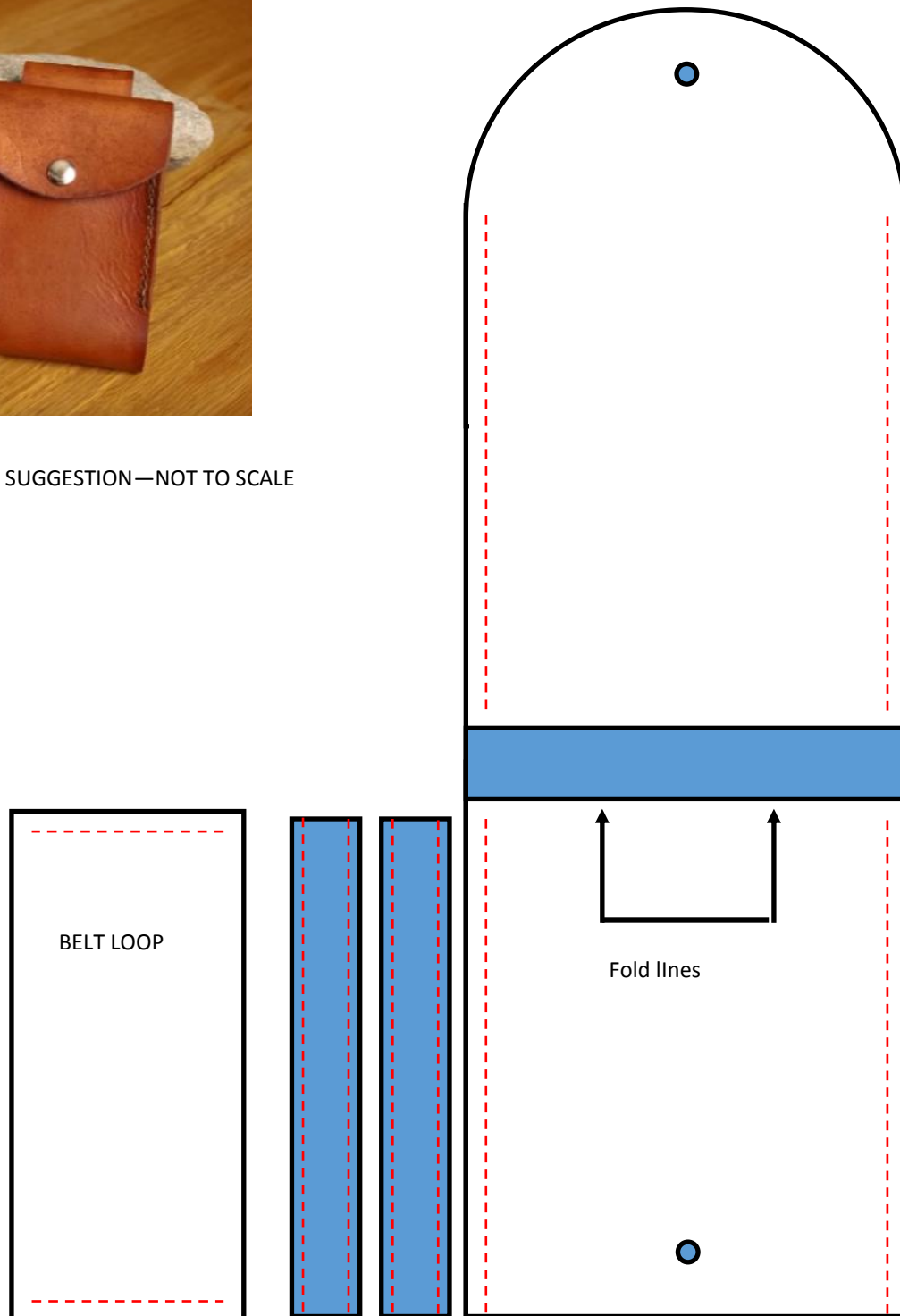
