RE: scientific Europe a threat

I am an independent researcher, PhD, an Israeli citizen, 81. For about 30 years I have been engaged in independent research in Systems Theory, first in Russia and since 1992 in Israel and abroad; late last century that research yielded results of fundamental significance for science in general and physics in particular. Although I published my research in physics in print and online (2007-2009), European universities and conferences have repeatedly denied me the opportunity to report and discuss it. The main reasons for that failure were the conservatism of the European establishment and perhaps the activity of Russian agents, who since my emigration from Russia have been waging an omnipresent secret war against me.

As to my research, it initiates the reform of modern physics and, due to its new method rooted in philosophy, paves the way to the reform of modern science in general including humanities. This is the more important that, as an analysis shows, the crisis of modern science is underlying the present general ideological crisis of civilization now threatening the very existence of humankind. So my current mission is to proceed with the reform of modern science, which certainly presupposes international support and a coordinating center. Seeking such a support, 9.04.17 and additionally 20.04.17, I applied to Dr. Ann Mettler, the EPSC Director-General, but there have been no promising signals from the EPSC in this regard yet.

The main conclusion is this: because of the above general ideological crisis and the traditional European conservatism, the main European scientific centers, such as UNESCO, CERN, ICTP, EPS, the Swedish Academy, etc. to protect their obscurantist views and their position in science, have been inadvertently developing an ideological breeding-ground for the resurrection of nationalism, chauvinism and fascism, cultivating a biased ethics in science, promoting indirectly terrorism and pushing civilization to a new world war.

In this connection, if you think my above mission to be indeed important for the destiny of Europe, would you please instruct the EPSC to propose an affordable road map to the realization of that mission. Please see more online information on the matter enclosed.
