

15-year-old Mason Greer is a very accomplished Mississauga-based singer who has performed on many stages, including centre ice at the Air Canada Centre as an anthem singer for the Toronto Maple Leafs. He is considered one of the youngest anthem singers in Toronto Maple Leaf history.

Mason has performed the anthem on several professional sporting stages including the Toronto Blue Jays, the Toronto Marlies, Harness racing for Standardbred Canada's 2016 O'Brien awards, and opening for the 2016 World Cup of Hockey. World Ringuette will be the next sport that he checks off his list.

After the biggest stage in Canadian sports opened the doors for Mason, an even bigger opportunity came his way. [Michael Hanson](#) the former Glass Tiger drummer and five time Juno award winner teamed up with Greer and the two of them have been recording original pop songs together ever since.
