

## Student Dress Code

Responsibility for the personal appearance of students enrolled in the South Shore School District shall normally rest with the students themselves. Students are expected to use good judgment and come to school neat and clean.

The administration may refuse to allow a student to attend classes if the student's clothing or apparel is determined to be either disruptive to the operation of the school, a health hazard, or is incompatible with the district's mission or instructional goals.

Clothing with alcohol, drug, or tobacco messages is prohibited. Clothing with written or graphic sexual connotations, or racial, ethnic or religious slurs is also prohibited. Students coming to school wearing an item of clothing with the above descriptions will be required to change to different clothing.

Students who repeatedly wear prohibited clothing to school shall also be subject to further disciplinary action according to the District's general code of student conduct.

Headcoverings shall not be worn within the school building during normal school hours unless special circumstances are approved by the administration.
