- 7. Items for discussion and consideration:
 - A. Discussion on Little League Field Playground Project (DNR Passport Grant Application)
 - I. Director Bergman discussed the recommendation to apply for Land & Water Conservation Grant. 2 representatives from the Ironwood Little League spoke about the work that had been done and the work that needs to be done for the grant. They discussed the difficulty with coming up with a match for the field. The Little League organization stated that the they aren't ready to apply for the grant.

 - I. Strategy 4.5 Define and Construct Priority Trail Improvements (Regional Trail to Miners and Beltline) All Members.
 - a. Update on grant application for Beltline
 - Director Bergman stated that the City has been recommended for funding by the DNR.
 - b. Update on Neighborhood Enhancement Grant (Trail Connections)
 - i. Director Bergman stated that the Gogebic Range Health Foundation, along with the City of Ironwood, has applied for a grant to fund a trail from the Little League Field to the Miners Memorial Heritage Park.
 - c. Mountain Bike Trail Development Project:
 - i. Director Bergman stated that the original Mt. Zion trails are postponed. They are changing the mountain bike trails locations to the Miners Memorial Heritage Park.

Motion by Davey to support the mountain bike project in the Miners Memorial Heritage Park. **Second** by Kostelnik. **Motion Carried 5 to 1 with True opposing.**
