Dear Mr. Tillerson:

RE: Cooperation for a vital mission

I have decided to consult you on a political issue of vital importance, in my view, for the destiny of civilization. As my analysis shows, civilization has been experiencing **a general ideological crisis** now threatening the very existence of humankind. The current political conflicts, such as those in the Eastern Europe, the Middle East, Korea, etc., are mere particular manifestations of that general crisis. So to ensure the future of civilization, it is necessary to settle that general crisis first of all.

To settle the above general crisis, it would be necessary to reform the ideology of modern society, that is its science, philosophy and religion, which is certainly quite a task in itself. Fortunately, in the course of my half-life-long research in exact sciences and humanities, I have managed to discover the true interpretation of the General System Theory, which enabled me to develop the General Methodology of the Reform and start reforming modern science, creating in particular the framework of the true Science of Politics, the science that did not exist before. I was ready to proceed further with the reform of science, but such a historic mission cannot hinge long on the enthusiasm of a pensioner, it needs a broad international support.

My first task at present is to establish a coordinating center, **The World Reform Center (WRC)**, to manage the reform worldwide. The best solution would be to commit UNESCO or its part to that task; otherwise it would be necessary to set up an independent institute, an NGO for ten or so persons with the same task. Seeking support for my mission, I have applied to universities, conferences, scientific, international, governmental and social organizations, including the UN and UNESCO, but in vain. The main reasons for that failure seem to be the following:

- a radical, sweeping character of my research questioning many of the existing theories and programs;
- my status of Independent Researcher challenging the present caste-like university professorship;
- the monstrous crisis of modern science and the general corruption of scientific establishment;
- the interference of Russian agents conspiring against me with their counterparts in Europe and Israel.

In the course of the above global reformatory mission, the present political systems are supposed to be radically reformed, both on national and international levels. As such a great reform cannot be achieved without the participation of influential and open-minded politicians, like you are, for example, I think you might be very much interested in joining this mission. If that happened, we could make history, transforming the whole world, protecting it from the present nuclear threats and paving the way to its prosperous future.

In this connection could you please consider the opportunity to join my above mission by setting up in Europe, possibly in Switzerland, the above Center, possibly with a Fund of 5-10 million dollar, becoming its President and inviting me as its Director General.
