RE: scientific approach to global policy

Having analyzed the problem of global policy from the scientific point of view, we arrived at the conclusion that the UN cannot be any longer the right instrument in maintaining global security for the following reasons:

- (1) the ideology of the UN is based on maintaining the *status quo*, while the world is a developing organic system where conflicts and wars are the necessary components of development;
- (2) when a serious conflict happens urging a social change, the UN, instead of providing the proper scientific ideology to elevate the moral of society, facilitate its due development and resolve the conflict, usually offers some diplomatic measures aimed allegedly at solving the conflict but actually only aggravating it;
- (3) besides, for a smooth development of civilization it would be necessary to start settling its present general ideological crisis, the problem having been thoroughly ignored by the UN;
- (4) UNESCO, actually the brain of the world, should have been committed with the task of developing the proper political ideology to manage the world, but it seems to have been fundamentally misled and shackled by its Charter and would need a thorough reorganization to do the job.

In the course of our 40-year-long research in exact sciences and humanities we have succeeded in creating the framework of the true science of politics that could be used for settling conflicts and the above ideological crisis (see Enclosure), but our efforts to get international support for that our mission have so far been unsuccessful.

In this connection, now that the prospect of a new world war has becoming ever more real, would you please consider an opportunity of convening an international conference aimed at discussing the scientific approach to global policy suggested by our works and working out recommendations for the respective reorganization of the whole system of global governance; the title of the conference being for example "*Science, Ideology and Global Governance*".
