 - III. Strategy 4.2 Prepare a Wayfinding Master Plan: Director Bergman stated that after the Medical Marijuana workshop is completed, staff will move on to the pedestrian system and then the Wayfinding Master Plan.
 - IV. Strategy 4.4 Prioritize, plan for and construct pedestrian system improvements: Director Bergman stated that the City Commission wants to work together with the Planning Commission to finalize the plan.
- 7. Other Business: Korpela asked if the City was planning on giving an update on the fire that happened in downtown. Director Bergman stated that the demolition contracted has started to demolish the building. He also discussed trying to get the adjacent businesses open.
