Dear Mr. Netanyahu: RE: appeal for urgent assistance I am an Israeli citizen, 82, an independent researcher, PhD. I apply to you for an urgent assistance in my personal matters as well as in matters of Jewish and international importance.

My current mission, based on my decades-long research in exact sciences and humanities, is aimed at settling the present general ideological crisis of civilization now threatening the destiny of humankind, the destiny of the Jewish people in particular. However I have many enemies who have been trying to undermine and obstruct my mission wherever possible.

On June 27, 2018, I visited Greece to participate at the Atiner International Philosophy Conference, When returning to Israel, June 29, I found my Israel passport stolen. With the help of the Greek Border Police, who gave me the proper certificate, I returned to Israel. On June 30, I applied to the Ministry of Interior in Haifa to restore the Passport and renew my ID card to be expired soon. The clerk proposed me the digital style of the documents, I agreed and paid 540 shekel for that. In two weeks I received the documents but with such distortions that put in doubt my identity: with a wry signature of mine on the passport and with my ID Card photo almost absent, not recognizable at least (see Enclosure). I think everybody understands what the absence of a recognizable photo on the ID card suggests. So now I must take care more not of the world security but rather of my own security.

In this connection, taking into account the world importance of my unique mission, would you please consider the possibility of the following urgent measures:

(1) providing me with a secure private accommodation in Tel Aviv, instead of the present hostel in Haifa controlled thoroughly by Russian agents waging an omnipresent secret war against me in cooperation with some local authorities;

(2) supporting my mission aimed in particular at settling the currently intractable conflicts between Israel and its Middle East neighbors, the conflicts degrading the moral of the Jewish people, worsening the international image of Israel and threatening with a new world war;

(3) giving the proper instructions to the Ministry of Interior concerning the necessity to observe international standards in producing state documents.
