

- c. Remove the 6 screws and 6 clips.





- g. w/o TOYOTA Parking Assist-sensor System, w/ Fog Light: Disconnect the 2 connectors.

- w/ Headlight Cleaner System: Disconnect the headlight cleaner hose.
- i. Remove the front bumper cover.




4. REMOVE FRONT BUMPER BAR REINFORCEMENT LH
