# **Before Starting:**

String beads onto thread in this order:

2 seed beads, 2 bugle beads, 22 seed beads

Wind 1 yard on shuttle CTM, leave 2 seed beads on the ball thread

### Round 1

Put 2 bugle beads and 12 seed beads on the back of your hand

lj- lock join

rw- reverse work (only added in places where you otherwise might not rw)

3sb/1sb- add 3 beads on working thread and 1 on core thread

Pull up 2 beads from shuttle and 2 beads from ball thread to make a mock picot




