 - I. Davey talked about re-routing the motorized trail crossing that crosses the Iron Belle trail to Frederick Street.
- C. Discussion on Civic Center.
 - I. The Civic Center will either be reconstructed in the current location or in a new location. The Committee looked at 2 other potential sites within the City limits.
- D. Update on sledding hill.
 - I. The Committee discussed Brogan hill as one of the best options, with the old dump site removed as an option. A snow pile was talked about as an option in the City's snow dump site. They questioned the need to make sure that a sledding hill is covered under the City's insurance

 - Strategy 4.5 Define and Construct Priority Trail Improvements (Regional Trail to Miners and Beltline).
