



Flutterby Heart by Marilee Rockley

Easy pattern using 1 shuttle and a ball. The butterfly with antennae is made first, and then round 2 is added. In size 10 thread the finished motif measures 2.25 inches (5.8 cm) wide; in size 20 it's 1.75 inches (4.5 cm) wide.

Butterfly: Start at top ring.

R 8 - 4. RW.

Ch 10 - 1. RW.

Large R 12 - 10 - 2. Do not RW.

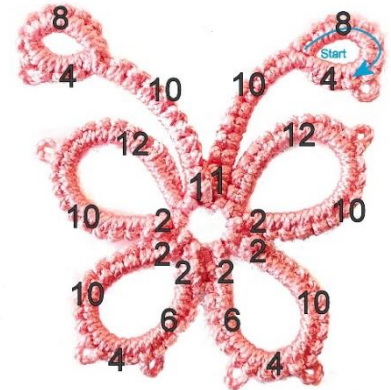
Large R 2 + 10 - 4 - 6 - 2 (to last picot of previous ring).

Large R 2 + 6 - 4 - 10 - 2 (to last picot of previous ring).

Large R 2 + 10 - 12 (to last picot of previous ring). RW.

Ch 1 + 10 (joining to picot of adjacent chain). RW.

R 4 - 8. **Tip:** to hide ends without sewing, tat this ring as a single shuttle split ring. Cut threads.



Round 2:

LJ between the antenna and first large ring.

Ch 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 + 2 - 2 - 2 (to picot of top ring). LJ to picot of large ring. RW.

R 2 - 2 - 2 - 2. RW.

Ch 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2. LJ to center picot of previous ring. RW.

R 2 - 2 - 2 - 2. RW.

Ch 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2. LJ to center picot of previous ring. RW.

R 2 - 2 + 2 - 2 (to nearest picot of next large ring). RW.

Ch 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2. LJ to same picot previously joined. Do not RW.

Ch 2 - 2. LJ to next picot of same large ring. RW. Switch threads with Shoelace Trick.



Tail: Ch 7 - 2. RW. R 4 - 4. RW. Ch 2 + 7 (to picot of previous chain). LJ to nearest picot of next large ring. RW.

Ch 2 - 2. LJ to next picot of same large ring. RW.

R 2 - 2 - 2 - 2. RW.

Ch 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2. LJ to center picot of previous ring. RW.

R 2 - 2 - 2 - 2. RW.

Ch 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2. LJ to center picot of previous ring. RW.

R 2 - 2 + 2 - 2 (to picot of large ring). RW.

Ch 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 - 2. LJ to same picot of large ring previously joined. Do not RW.

Ch 2 - 2 - 2 + 2 - 2 - 2 - 2 (to picot of top ring, keeping the ball thread at top of work). LJ between last large ring and chain of butterfly. Tie, hide ends, and cut.
