

SCHOOL BOARD ELECTIONS

The Board of the South Shore School District shall be elected at the general spring election (held on the first Tuesday in April of each year), following the procedure outlined for such election by the state statutes.

Board members shall be elected at large by plurality vote of the electors of the district and shall reside in specific geographic areas except as otherwise provided. Two members of the seven-member Board shall be elected each year, with the exception of every third year when three members will be elected.

An elected Board member's term of office shall commence on the fourth Monday in April. Before taking office, a Board member must take and sign an oath of office administered by the Board Clerk.
