

BOARD MEMBER RESIGNATIONS

School board member resignations should be made in writing to the clerk or to the president if the clerk resigns. A resignation will become effective on the date indicated or upon delivery if no date indicated.

When a Board member ceases to be a resident or remains absent from the district for a period exceeding 60 consecutive days, except in extenuating situations with board approval his/her Board member seat shall be considered vacant. The Board shall fill the vacancy in accordance with established procedures.
