

BOARD OPERATIONAL GOALS

The Board is committed to the education of all students as appropriate to the best of their individual abilities, to a constant awareness of the concerns and desires of the whole community regarding the quality and performance of the school system, and to the employment of a district administrator who will see that the district maintains a position as an outstanding school system and under whose leadership school personnel will carry out the policies of the Board with imagination and dedication.

Additionally, the Board commits itself to the following objectives:

1. To control spending in the district by doing cost analyses and maintaining reasonable tax levies, while improving the quality of curriculum and student/teacher contact time.
2. To improve means of communicating the district's needs and accomplishments through increased community involvement.
3. To review and update Board policies on a regular basis.
4. To develop short and long-range plans for buildings and grounds.
5. To encourage and develop rapport between the Board and district employees.
6. To promote a plan for the organized improvement of school curriculum, including the articulation between all district schools.
