

KINDERGARTEN INSTRUCTION

The South Shore School District shall operate a kindergarten program for eligible students in the district. Children who are five years old on or before September 1 will be eligible for admission to kindergarten. Early admission to kindergarten may be permitted in accordance with established procedures.

Kindergarten instruction shall be held on an all-day, five day per week schedule.

The kindergarten program shall include opportunities for learning basic concepts and skills in language art, fine arts, social studies, mathematics, science, health and physical education. The kindergarten teachers shall be certified by the Department of Public Instruction.
