

GIFTED AND TALENTED PROGRAM

The South Shore School District shall strive to offer each student experiences appropriate to his/her individual needs, interests and capabilities.

Gifted and talented programs shall be established which provide the potentially high achieving student with an opportunity to develop skills in inquiry and creative expression at a rate and to an extent appropriate to his/her ability. "Gifted and talented students" shall include those students who give evidence of high performance capability in intellectual, creative, artistic, leadership or specific academic areas and who need services or activities not ordinarily provided in a regular school program. Students shall be identified as gifted and talented in accordance with guidelines.

The Board shall periodically review gifted and talented programs as developed in the District's Gifted and Talented Plan.
