

**PROGRAMS FOR CHILDREN AT RISK**

The Board shall establish plans to serve children in the district who are identified at risk of not graduating from high school.

All plans developed for children at risk shall be designed to:

- a. Improve and expand educational opportunities for these children on an individualized basis, through a variety of means (e.g. remedial instruction);
- b. Provide alternative courses or program modifications which satisfactorily meet the school district graduation requirements;
- c. Encourage parental involvement; and
- d. Encourage cooperation with community support service agencies.

Students shall be identified and referred to these plans in accordance with state regulations and guidelines established by the administration.
