



## **510 Shared Time Programs**

### **I. Purpose**

The purpose of this policy is to recognize and provide guidelines in accordance with state law for parents who wish to have their child receive education in both a home school and North Shore Community School.

### **II. General Statement of Policy**

A home-schooled child may be permitted to enroll in classes at North Shore Community School as a shared time pupil. North Shore Community School may limit enrollment of shared time pupils in classes based on capacity of the class, grade-level, or wait lists of students requesting full time enrollment. The school board and administration retain sole discretion and control over scheduling of all classes and assignment of shared time pupils to classes.

### **III. Conditions for Participation in a Shared Time Program**

- A. The student must have prior approval from the North Shore Community School director and the resident district prior to enrolling as a shared time student.
- B. North Shore Community School must be able to receive tuition reimbursement from the student's resident district for the entire percentage of time s/he attends classes at North Shore Community School.

### **IV. Transportation**

- A. North Shore Community School may provide transportation for shared time pupils.
- B. North Shore Community School retains sole discretion, control and management of scheduling routes, establishing bus stops, manner and method of transportation, and all other matters relating to the provision of transportation services.
