Bear Hug







A fun, quick make, ideal for rainy days... the bear can be made as it is or mounted to a greeting card. Why not send in the post to someone you haven't seen for a while and spread some love.

Leather

Any scrap remnant can work—if your leather is very thin and floppy, glue two pieces together. The photo shows Identity <u>Soft Calf</u>, with the bear belly reversed out to suede, and a scrap of pig suede for the scarf.

If you wish to make a polar bear version use the White Botannical Calf Leather.

Tools:

Leather scissors, black pen

Materials:

Magnet—pair, or a piece of Velcro, Leathercraft Cement or other craft glue suitable for leather

Instructions:


- 1. Cut out the bear body template and draw round on the back of your leather scrap, reverse and draw round the bear belly template and cut out.
- 2. Use the leather scissors to carefully cut out your shape. Cut out a contrast leather or fabric for the scarf pieces.
- 3. Glue the magnets in place as indicated. Then glue the bear belly over the top.
- 4. Glue the scarf piece 1 in place and then scarf piece 2 to lie slightly over the top.
- 5. With a black pen draw in the claws, eyes, nose and mouth. Leave to dry.
