  - C. Update on Downtown Historical Signage Project: The signs are in and we are waiting for installation.
  - D. Pocket Park and Art Park snow shoveling proposals:

- E. Downtown Trees Update: Staff is waiting to hear back from Darrin Kimbier on the best route to take.
- F. Wreath lights purchase: Erickson asked for funding to purchase downtown wreath lights.

Motion by Flory to purchase \$200 worth of Christmas lights for the wreaths, second by Alexander. Motion carried 6 to 0.
