

## Notes for Working Meeting of August 23, 2023

### ***Further tweaking of survey questions – QR Code, contact with Chamber & DIDA?***

May not need to change the questions. Did not contact M. Myers about putting the survey into the Chamber Newsletter. So, the next Chamber Newsletter may go out in September. Will try to get the survey and QR code into that one. Where else would we like to try to get feedback.

Some discussion about passive or active gathering of feedback. More passivity may be better – take the QR code to places: theatre performances, football games, etc.

Materials needed would be 20 poster-type fliers, large number of smaller square sheets with QR code, maybe business cards, and the lanyards. T Patel will work on development of these.

***Dashboard for Traffic Stop Data --***

The idea is to offer two pieces of information: yes our officers are doing things correctly; yes, we are showing the public that we are doing things correctly.

Next steps on this project will be to get more data from further back in time. Patel will then take the data and break it into dashboard categories for analysis, so it can be used for officer educational purposes, and for use in public reports that show the IPSD is doing things correctly as far as diversity, equity, and inclusion are concerned.
