1. Introduction

2. Using Public transportation



If you are getting to Church with public transportation the closest metro and bus stops are Bourdonnette, UNIL Mouline and Chavannes R. Dorigny.

a) From Lausanne Bourdonnette

You can get to Lausanne Bourdonnette with the bus 24 and 701 and with the metro M1. From Lausanne Bourdonnette to the Church building it's bit of an uphill 7-minute walk. If you are coming from the bus stop you need to walk to the other side of the metro tracks through the underpass and turn left. If you are coming from Renens with the M1, you will also need to cross the tracks to go down the other side. If you are coming from Lausanne you will just need to walk down the stairs.

As you can see from the map, once you go out from the Bourdonnette station, you will just need to walk straight up the little hill, through the park.





See the pictures below in order to see what the walk looks like.



This route is accessible, there are ramps that you can take instead of the stairs for going down from the metro stops. However, the route is uphill.

b) From UNIL Mouline




You can also take the M1 to Mouline or the bus 31, which are very close to each other. In that case you are going to walk towards Route du Léman to turn north when you get to the underpass. After that you will turn right on Rue Antoinette Quinche. As you can see from the map below and the pictures showing you the way.



This route is accessible, there is an elevator from getting from route du Léman to the building complex that is just to the right of the stairs.

c) From Chavannes R. Dorigny

The bus 25 leaves you at the bus stop at Chavannes R. Dorigny, from there you just need to cross the street and go towards the building complex, then go straight and to the left.



This route is accessible, it's all flat

3. Getting there by car




If you are driving you can park in the underground parking (height limit 2.15m). You need to take a ticket at entry and pay on exit. If you don't want to use the underground parking, roadside parking is available near to the Renens Piscine, or on the UNIL campus.

There are two entrances by car - one on Rue du Léman, and one on Rte de Chavannes (marked as Migros). If you enter from Rue du Léman, drive to Sector C. This means that immediately after the entrance barrier you take a left hand turn (before the barriers to lower level private parking) and then immediately turn right.



The drive straight ahead for several hundred metres until you reach sector C. You'll then see a 'Sortie' sign overhead, turn left at that sign, but then turn left again almost immediately (before heading up the ramp and out of the carpark!) Now find a white parking space - most are on the right - labelled 'Salle Polyvalent, Visiteur, or Commerce.

If you enter from Route de Chavannes (the entrance has a Migros sign over it), go through the barrier, drive down the ramp, and then immediately turn right. Now find a white parking space - most are on the right - labelled 'Salle Polyvalent, Visiteur, or Commerce.

Once parked, use the Entrance/Sortie 1. Go up the stairs, exit into the courtyard and you will find the main entrance for the Sunday Service on your right.



Entering from Route de Chavannes:



This route is accessible, you can use the elevator next to the stairs.
