### **While some practice caution, others continue unsafe practices.**

The word says a wise person sees evil and flees Prov. 27:11-12. and as Jesus refused to put God to the test, so should we. Today, there are 4 persons under voluntary quarantine impacting both Annual Conferences. Stop hugging, a waive or wink is better than a touch. If possible, put space between your seat and persons who do not live with you. Wash hands for 20 seconds, and don't touch your face with unwashed hands. Try not to touch things in public places. A shorter service lessens exposure. Support your church by giving more, deep cleaning and other issues are stressing budgets.
