



Step-by-Step Instructions for making a Photo Pendant

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ATTENTION: THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS ARE COMPANION TO THE YOUTUBE VIDEO

1. Print out miniature photo to ensure size matches cabochon (cab) size; simply place cab on top of picture to ensure it covers desired photo area
2. Trace cab around picture with a pencil or cut out with large hole punch
3. Squeeze a drop of sealer on photo; make sure it's enough so that when cab is placed on top that it covers entire picture area
4. Place cab on top of picture and press down; make sure it fits as neatly as possible over photo
5. Hold the cab and picture firmly down on a sheet of paper to squeeze out air bubbles
6. Move cab around so that it does not stick to paper and wipe off any excess sealer with alcohol on a paper towel
7. Let cab and picture dry (for Diamond Seal about 20 minutes)
8. Squeeze drops of sealer inside of pendant
9. Position cab/photo inside pendant and press down
10. For best results let dry overnight
11. Happy Creating!!!

Materials Need

- Inkjet printer
- 50lb (approximately) white matte paper
- Cabochons (two popular sizes are 1 inch or $\frac{3}{4}$ inch)
- Matching size pendant
- Sealer/Glue (exp. Diamond Glaze)
- Scissors or Large hole punch size of cabochons
- A sheet of paper to protect working space; rubbing alcohol and paper towel to clean excess sealer
